

## Sending Crash Reports from Macs

Sending crash reports are crucial to making iRCT more stable and reliable.

There is no personal data in a crash report, a crash report for CyberTuner will have a file name such as:

```
CyberTuner_2014-05-01-114448_John_Tuner-iPhone.crash
```

To send CyberTuner crash logs to the iRCT team:

1. Sync your iOS device with iTunes.
2. In the Finder, open a new window. Choose Go > Go to Folder.
3. Enter ~/Library/Logs/CrashReporter/MobileDevice.
4. Open the folder named after your device's name.
5. Select the crash logs named after the application you're testing.
6. Choose Finder > Services > Mail > Send File.
7. In the New Message window, enter dean@reyburn.com in the To field and "CyberTuner crash logs from <your\_name> (for example, "CyberTuner crash logs from John Tuner") in the Subject field.
8. Choose Message > Send.
9. In the Finder, you may delete the crash logs you sent to avoid sending duplicate reports later.
